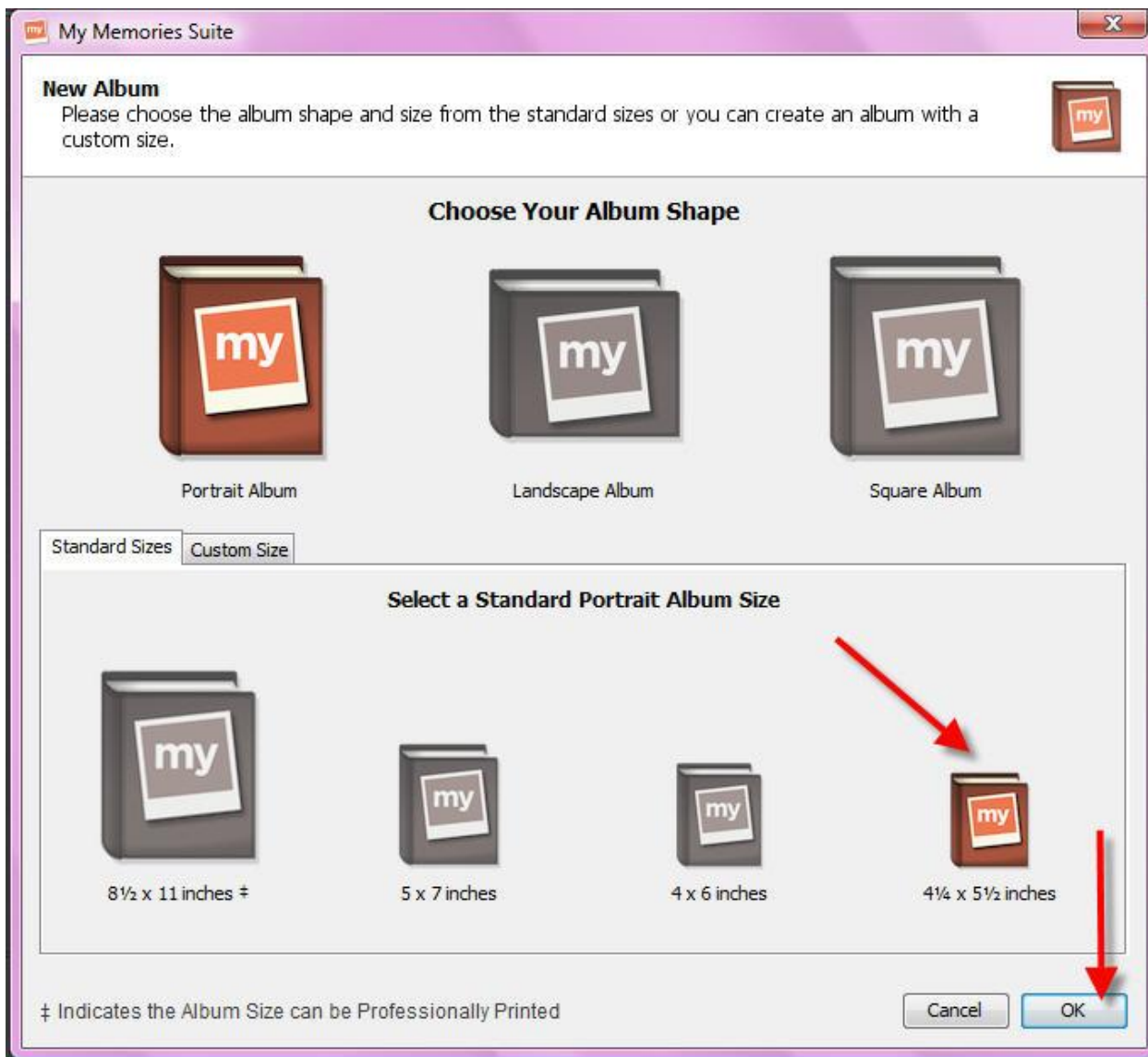


Quick and Easy Card Making Using [MyMemories Suite v3](#)

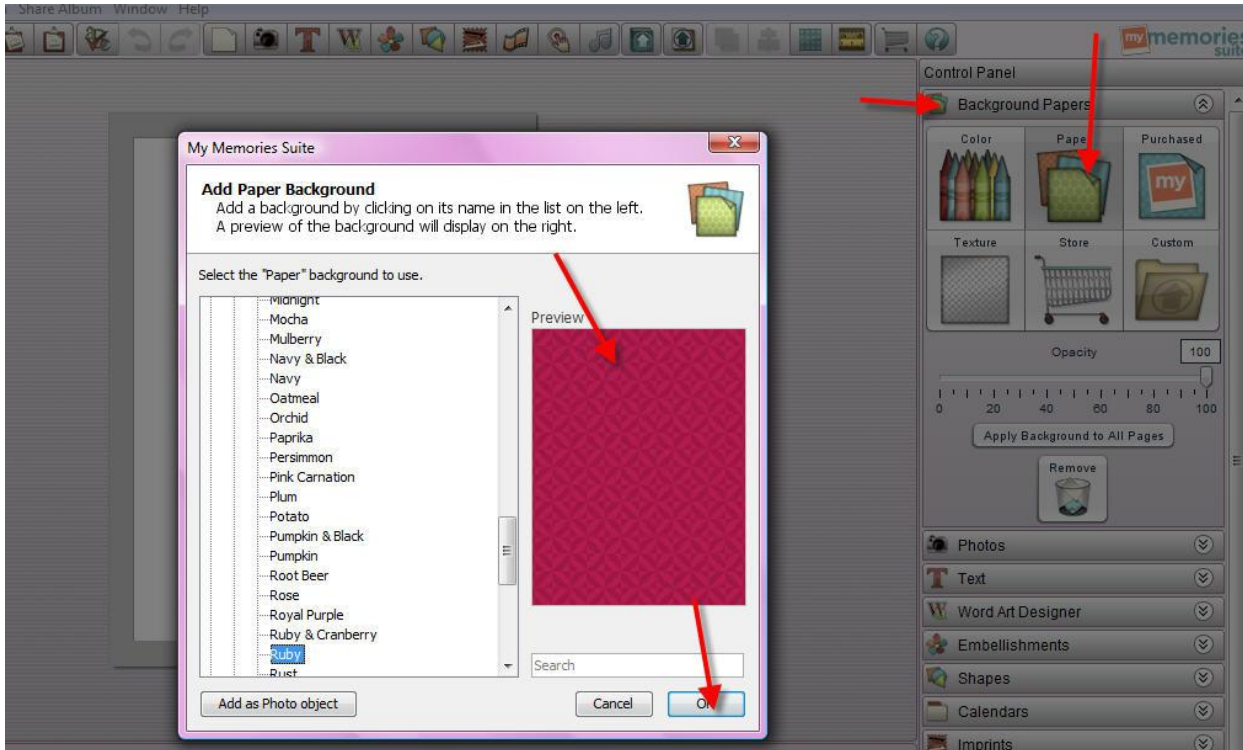

I love card making, in fact I started out in the craft industry as a professional card maker. I'm not someone who would rather pay \$5 for a store bought card when I can make one and have it mean something more to the person I'm giving it to! I'd like to show you have fast and easy it is to create multiple Greeting Cards in a jiffy using [MyMemories Suite Software](#)!

First, open up MyMemories Suite, and chose to create your design album type. Then choose the 4 ¼ x 5 ½ size – and click OK:

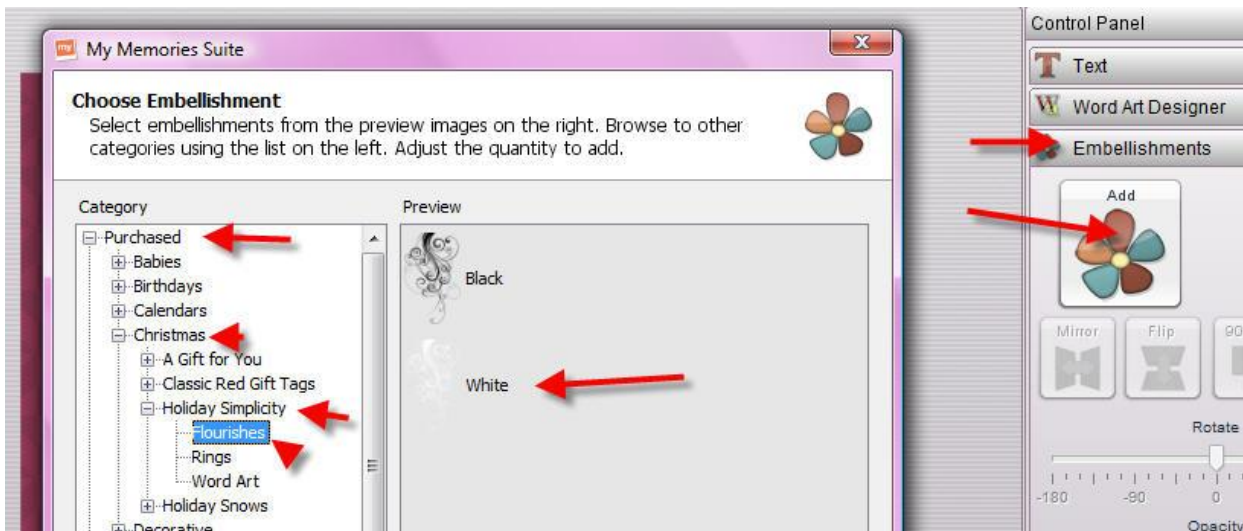


To add the card base, I chose Background Papers → Papers → Decorative → Large Jewel → Ruby → click OK

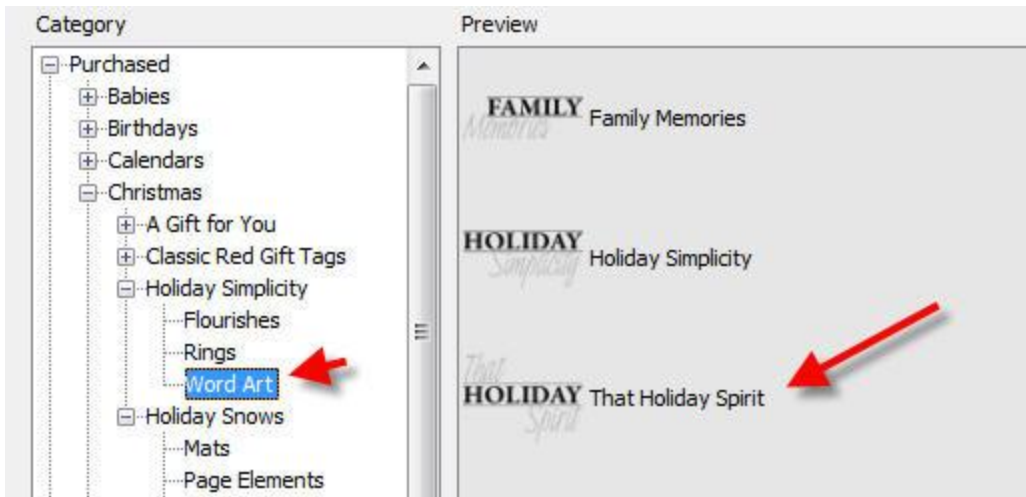


This will bring your paper onto your work surface. It sized for me as I wished, so I continued by adding a flourish and some word art.

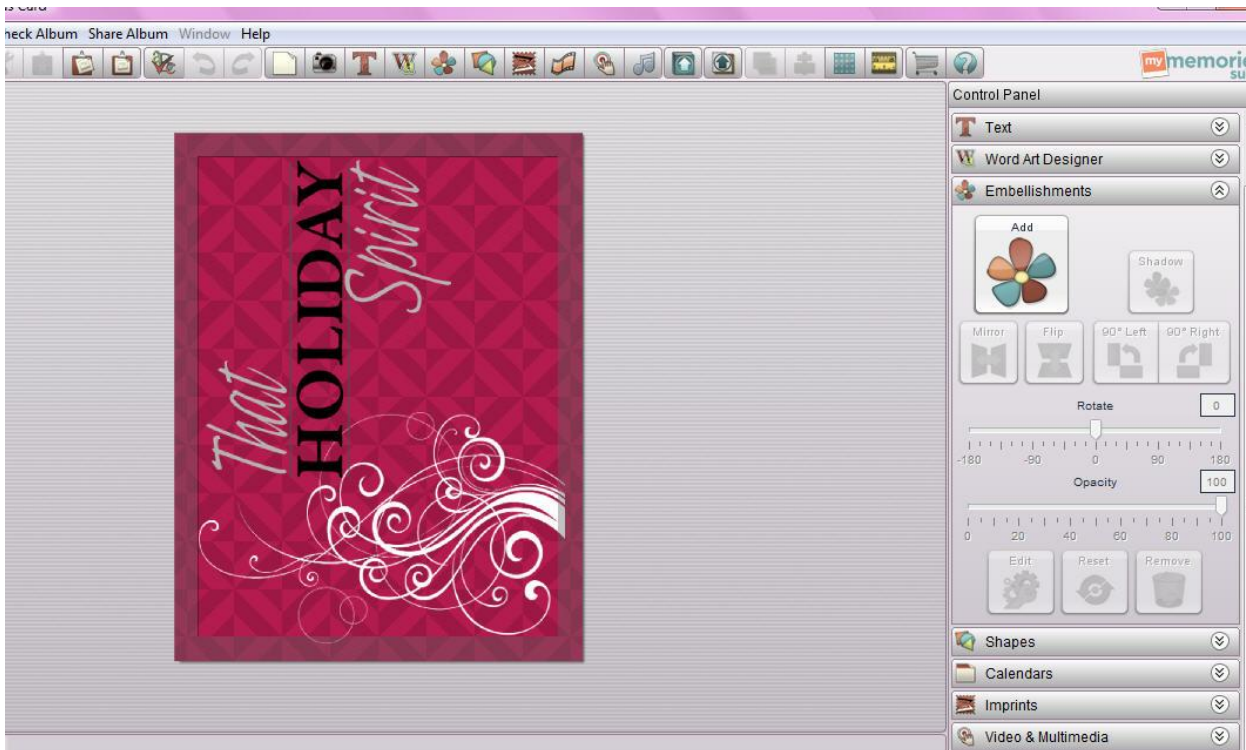
Click: Embellishments → Purchased → Christmas → Holiday Simplicity → Flourishes → I chose the white one and clicked OK.



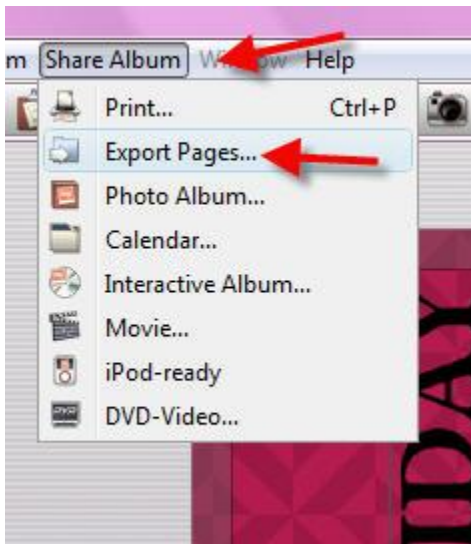
And then I did the same for the Word Art from the same kit and chose "That Holiday Spirit" and clicked OK



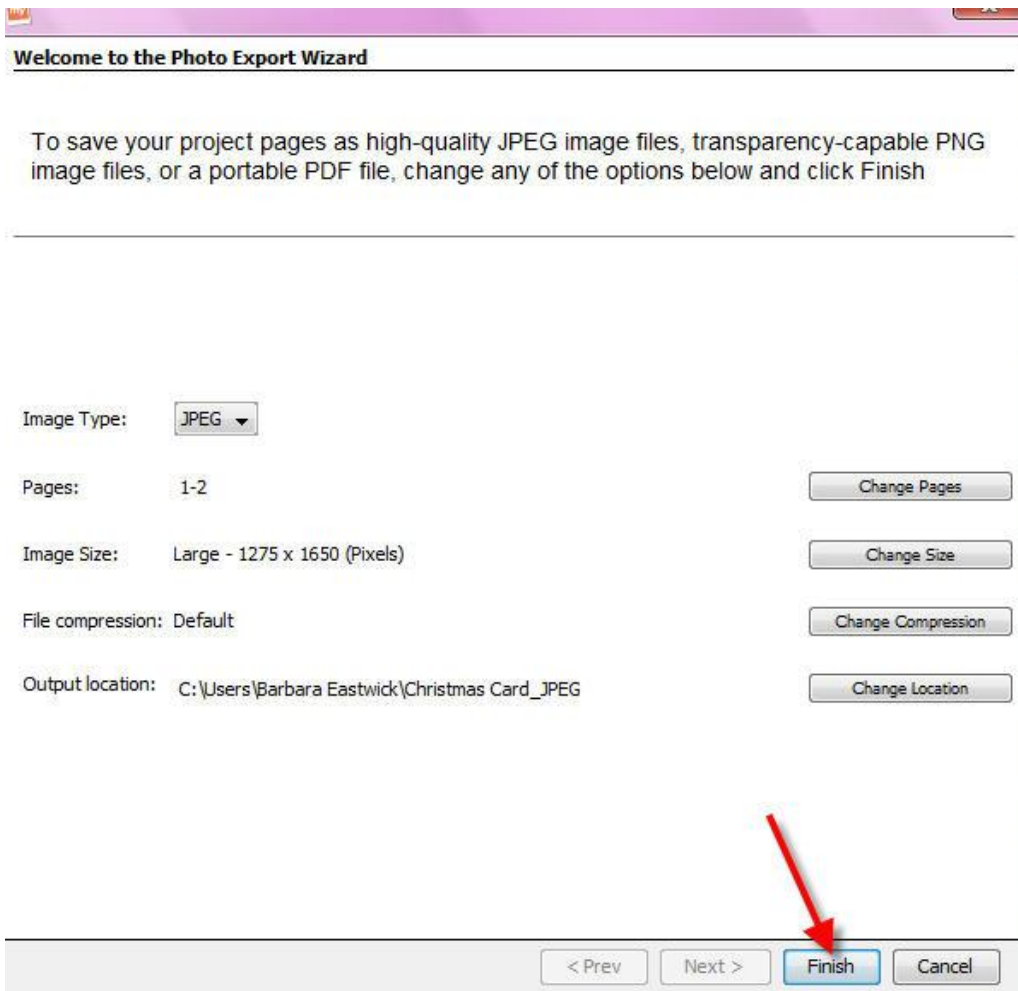
I simply organized the embellishments on the page and ensured they remained within the printing area:



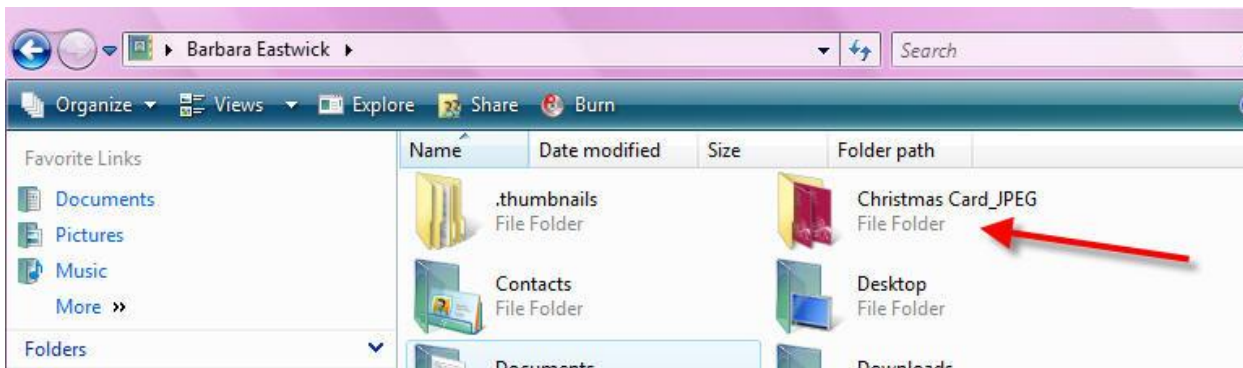
To save as a .jpg for printing, I clicked on: Share Album → Export Pages



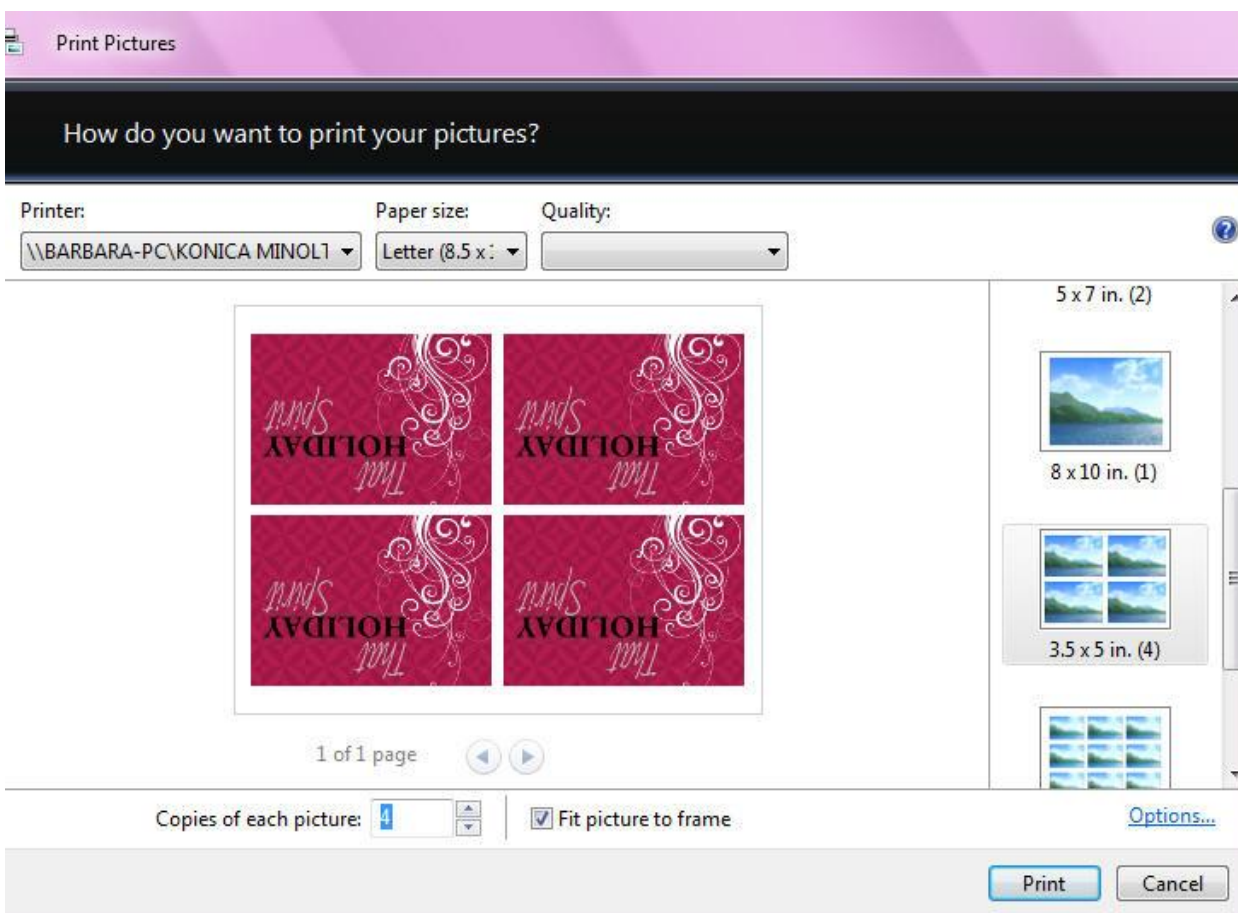
And then, I left the parameters as they were, and clicked Finish.



The image saved to a folder on my computer and I clicked to open the folder.



When I double click on the image I wish to print it brings up my default viewer, from here I chose to print my image as (4) 3.5 x 5 images on a single sheet. This may vary for whichever viewer software you use.



And I printed out this sheet of 4 card fronts.



And cut them out. Then I simply attached to the front of 4 patterned paper invitation size cards (4.25 x 5.5). I added a few sparkly jewels and a paper flower on one, and voila – 4 Holiday cards done in minutes!
